



# Jamaica - Certification Requirements

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## Acts and Regulations

Canned fish is subject to product specifications under the processed-food law.

Labeling and Marking Standards:

- Processed fishery products are subject to labelling and marking requirements. Every container of processed food must bear a code showing the date on which the food was packed, the process batch, the name of the processor and the place in which it was processed. Common names must be used in reference to spices, flavorings and colorings, as well as quantity, by weight or volume, of food ingredients. Letters used in labelling should be a prescribed size in relation to the size of the container.

## Tolerances or Guidelines

Radioactivity content must be below the following maximum levels:

Cesium	150 Bq/kg
Strontium	150 Bq/kg
Iodine 131	40 Bq/kg
